



MODERN SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING STATEMENT

Introduction

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes Propensio Finance ("the Company") slavery and human trafficking statement.

The Company recognises that the risks of modern slavery exist, and that modern slavery encompasses slavery, servitude, human trafficking and forced labour. Although the Company is not obliged under the scope of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 to publish a statement, we are committed to ensuring that there is none within our business or within our sub-contractor network, and as far as is practical that our suppliers are also committed to its eradication. This statement sets down the steps put in place and the Company's commitment to achieve this.

This Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement relates to actions and activities during the financial year 01/04/24 to 31/03/25.

Business

High Risk Areas

Based on our oversight of and relationship with our suppliers, we are confident that the risk of modern slavery or human trafficking involvement is very low risk.

Policies

The Company is committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our business or our supply chains. This Statement affirms its intention to act ethically in our business relationships.

The Company undertakes due diligence when considering taking on new suppliers, and regularly reviews its existing suppliers. The Company's due diligence process includes building long-standing relationships with suppliers. Where there is any concern regarding the behaviour of a supplier the business relationship will be terminated.


Performance indicators
